Sustainable Energy Investment Forums (SEI Forums) – the mother initiative of RoundBaltic

DG ENER – EASME initiative since 2016, multiple events across the EU

Aim: creating **dialogue** and enhancing the **capacity** of and **co-operation** between public and private stakeholders including finance sector; narrowing **investment** gap in sustainable energy

Developing ideas and recommendations for energy efficiency finance actions

Form: a series of **public conferences** (e.g. annual Covenant of Mayors Investment Forum – Energy Efficiency Finance Market Place), **national roundtable** discussions and **webinars**,

Event Leads Roundtables: EC Network and Climate Alliance (sub contractors: EnergyInvestment)

Two phases: 2016 – 2019; 2019 - 2023



- ❑ Target sectors: public buildings, private buildings, social housing, SME & industry sector
- ❑ Expected key outcomes:

 - National & regional roundtables with a view to generate ideas and recommendations for energy efficiency finance
 - Enabling actions to transform the ideas and recommendations into improved framework and initiation of concrete investments
 - Evaluation and learning of actions
 - Sustaining of the energy finance structures
- ❑ We organise exchange of methods and experiences throughout the Baltic Sea region and EU wide (incl. news bulletin of the project's learning events)

Investment framework

- Analysis of needs & opportunities

- Refining the intervention strategies according to the lessons learned

Roundtables

Enabling actions
